EARN A GIFTED AND TALENTED EDUCATION ENDORSEMENT BY COMPLETING ONLY 4 COURSES!

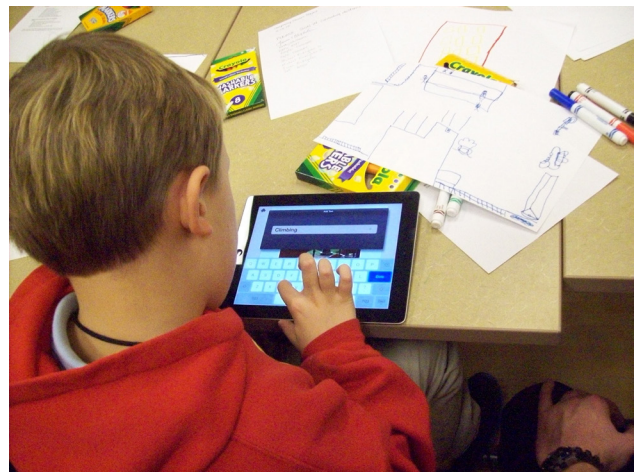
Teachers who want to add an endorsement to their certification can complete this program in just a few semesters. Courses are delivered in a hybrid format, partially online, or through face-to-face meetings at UofL, or local schools.

The Gifted and Talented Endorsement...

- Focuses on the nature and needs of the gifted, talented, and creative children in P-12 classrooms
- Provides ways to increase gifted behaviors in a greater number of children than those already identified
- May also be completed as part of the Master of Education in Teacher Leadership, a Rank I program, or as a standalone endorsement

Course Requirements:

- **EDSP 581:** *Introduction to Gifted Education* - delivered in fall 2018 as a hybrid course (a mix of online sessions and four face-to-face meetings)
- **EDSP 688:** *Diverse Populations of Gifted Students* - also delivered in fall 2018 as a hybrid course
- **EDSP 689:** *Curriculum and Instruction for Gifted and Talented Students* - course delivery is dependent upon the needs of our professional students
- **EDSP 690:** *Practicum in Gifted Education* - practicum may be completed in schools or at summer camps
