

CEHD ANNOUNCES **TUITION REDUCTION** FOR
SELECTED GRADUATE PROGRAMS IN EDUCATOR PREPARATION
BEGINNING SUMMER 2019

The **College of Education and Human Development** is launching a pilot program that offers a reduced tuition rate per credit hour for advanced educator preparation programs beginning Summer 2019. The *new tuition reduction rate for summer 2019 will be \$529 per credit hour for face-to-face and \$536 for online courses, which is approximately 25% less than the current graduate tuition rate.**

The following programs will offer the reduced tuition rate:

Master of Arts in Teaching (M.A.T.) with concentration areas in:

Interdisciplinary Early Childhood Education (B-P) (IECE)	Middle School Education (5-9) in English, Mathematics, Science, or Social Studies
Elementary Education (P-5)	Secondary Education (8-12) in Biology, Chemistry, Earth Science, English, Mathematics, Physics, Social Studies
Art Education (P-12)	Business and Marketing Education (5-12)
Health and Physical Education (P-12)	French (P-12) or Spanish (P-12)
Integrated Music Education (P-12)	Special Education in Moderate and Severe Disabilities (P-12)

- **Rank 1**

*The University of Louisville's base tuition rate is determined annually once the Kentucky State Legislature approves the recommendation from the University and the Council on Postsecondary Education (CPE). The 25% reduction will still remain in effect until Spring 2022.
